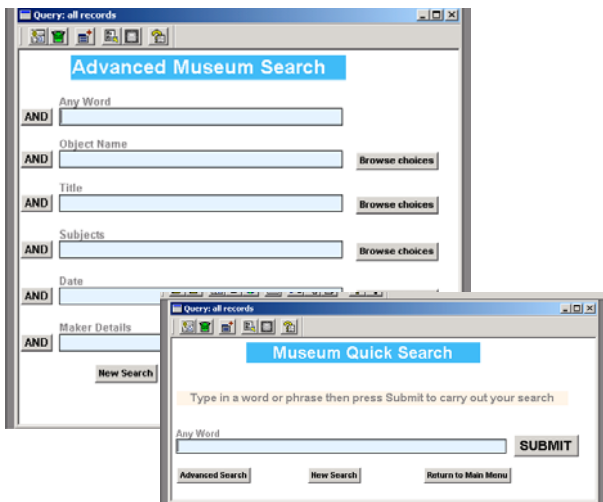

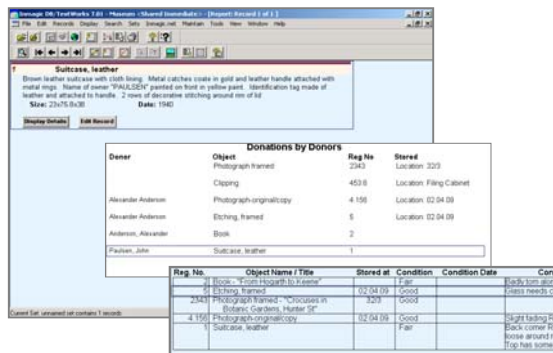

#### Data Entry is Quick and Easy

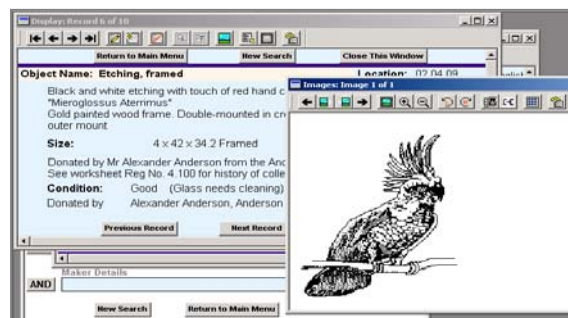
Data entry screens are designed to match the cataloguing worksheet recommended by Museums Australia. The menu will take you to the screen appropriate for the item you are cataloguing.
